Our beloved songbird is now a bona fide recording artist, having produced her first professional CD in Nashville, called "Songs That Speak To Me." It is a tribute to her favorite songwriter, John Denver. This is what Mike Taylor, John Denver's original guitarist and co-writer of "Rocky Mountain High" had to say about the album: "As you can imagine, I have heard many tributes to John in various forms and I must say that yours is as good as it gets!"

Judy has just returned to the desert after embarking on a three-and-a-half month voyage around the world with a "floating university" called Semester At Sea. She joined 800 passengers, including students from over 200 different universities, professors and staff. This 91st "Voyage Of Discovery" covered 22,000 miles and explored the cultures of Mexico, Hawaii, Japan, Hong Kong, Vietnam, Myanmar, India, Egypt, Turkey, Croatia, and Spain.

While on this voyage, Judy shared her music, of course, and collected 40 messages of peace for the John Denver Memorial Peace Cloth. The Peace Cloth is one way to get people to STOP and think, focus, meditate, pray, formulate an opinion, articulate a thought, and get it in a tangible form so that it can be shared with complete strangers from around the world ~ to MAKE A CONNECTION.

Judy will share her experiences, insights, and new perspectives on the world as seen through the eyes of her new friends from around the globe. Of particular interest to her were the stories of women who are taking on leadership roles in their government, of the peacekeepers, and the positive



action being taken to help women learn new skills, gain personal respect and support to pull themselves out of poverty.

Like many desert women, Judy Lunn has worn many hats. This Penn State graduate worked for 14 years in the tourism industry in accounting, convention services and sales. She switched gears to work in the technology industry a decade ago. She is a gifted teacher with an infinite amount of patience, and has taught over 3,000 people to overcome their fear of technology and become more productive and creative with their personal computer. She was the lead instructor for Gateway Computers and has taught for Elderhostel and the College of the Desert. As an entrepreneur, she now teaches privately throughout the Coachella Valley.

Since realizing her dream of becoming a recording artist, Judy's goal is to continue to grow and develop as an artist and to share the positive power of music with anyone who will listen. 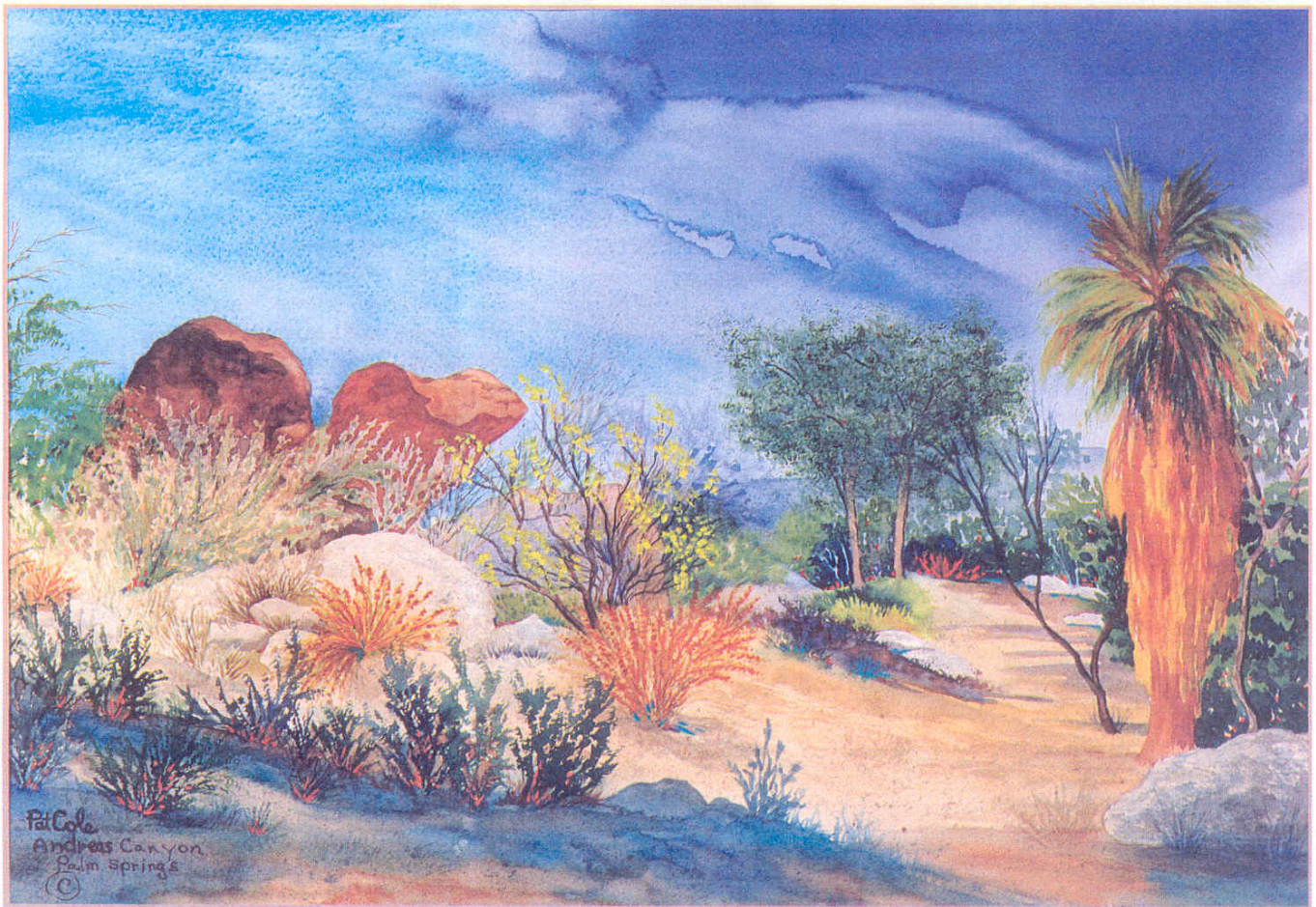
