Judy had an instant, genuine rapport with her audience she talked to us, walked through the ballroom as she sang, shook hands, patted us on the shoulder, danced with us, made eye contact and THANKED US for coming to her show. Imagine that!

Judy's song selection was wonderful – it included the classics from country, pop, oldies and acoustic folk – something for everyone. It was apparent that the music had meaning for her and she shared some stories about the songs before she sang them. She sang them with FEELING and we felt them too. People were moved to tears with the sad songs and laughter with the funny ones. They moved closer together, looked into each other's eyes, and sang along to the romantic ballads. We were totally engaged and connected with Judy for the duration of her show. To me – that is the sign of a true entertainer.

When I had the opportunity to meet her after her first show I expected to find the typical arrogant, egotistical, self-absorbed entertainer. That is what is so refreshing about Judy. She is the exact opposite of what you would expect from someone who gets a lot of attention and accolades. She is totally grounded and understands that her talent is a gift meant to be shared with others.

My first question to her was – *“Do you know the song “Piano Man” by Billy Joel? Because the line “They stand at the bar and put bread in my jar and say, Man, what are you doing here?” certainly applies to you!* Judy’s reply was “I love to travel and I love to sing and connect with people – that’s what I’m doing here!”


“That may be true now, but you won’t be here long. Producers like me will make your wildest dreams come true.” That’s what I told her and I know it will happen.

Obviously, I was not the only one smitten by her personality and talent. As a result of the survey taken of the 800 passengers on the December cruise, Judy was immediately contracted again to perform for 4 weeks on the next Semester At Sea cruise to Central America in May of 2009.

I had the pleasure of sailing with Judy for twenty-one days and truly enjoyed getting to know this fine young lady. I believe she has a very bright future wherever she decides to take her music. From my experience as a talent buyer and producer, I can tell you unequivocally that you cannot go wrong engaging the services of this performer.
